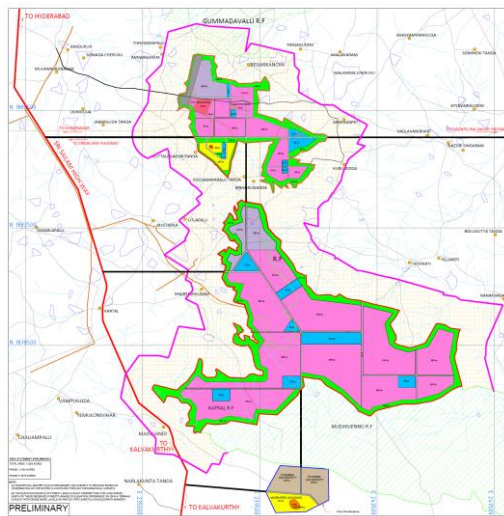

1.1 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1.1 The Authority invites Expression of Interest (EoI)s from national and international consultants for pre-qualification of Applicants who fulfill the eligibility criteria given in sections 3.1 and interested in participating for Preparation of Master Planning and Trunk Infrastructure Planning for the Project.
- 1.1.2 This EOI is issued for short listing of Applicants for Selection of Consultant for preparation of Integrated Master Plan for proposed Hyderabad Pharma City in Mucherla Village, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana State, India
- 1.1.3 This Expression of Interest document contains information about the pre-qualification requirements and process in relation to pre-qualification of the Applicants for further participation in the bidding process for the Project as per following sections:

1.2 ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- 1.2.1 The Applicant for pre-qualification may be a national or international firm, LLP or company, with the relevant experience in the field of master planning. Detailed description of the objectives, scope of services and other requirements relating to this consultancy are specified in this EOI. In case an applicant firm possesses the requisite experience and capabilities required for undertaking the services, it may participate in the Selection Process individually (the "Sole Firm") in response to this invitation. The term applicant (the "Applicant") means the Sole Firm.
- 1.2.1 Consultant shall have adequate and sufficient in-house resources and expertise to deliver this project in a timely manner.
- 1.2.2 The applicant shall be deemed to be ineligible to submit a proposal, if the organization has been barred or blacklisted by the Central and/or State Government or any agency thereunder in India
- 1.2.3 No consortiums/ joint ventures are permitted.
- 1.2.4 Prior to evaluation of Applications, the Authority shall determine whether each Application is responsive to the requirements of the EOI. An Application shall be considered responsive only if:
- (a) it is received as per the checklist at Annexure-I.

SECTION II: PROJECT INFORMATION

2.1 PROJECT BACKGROUND

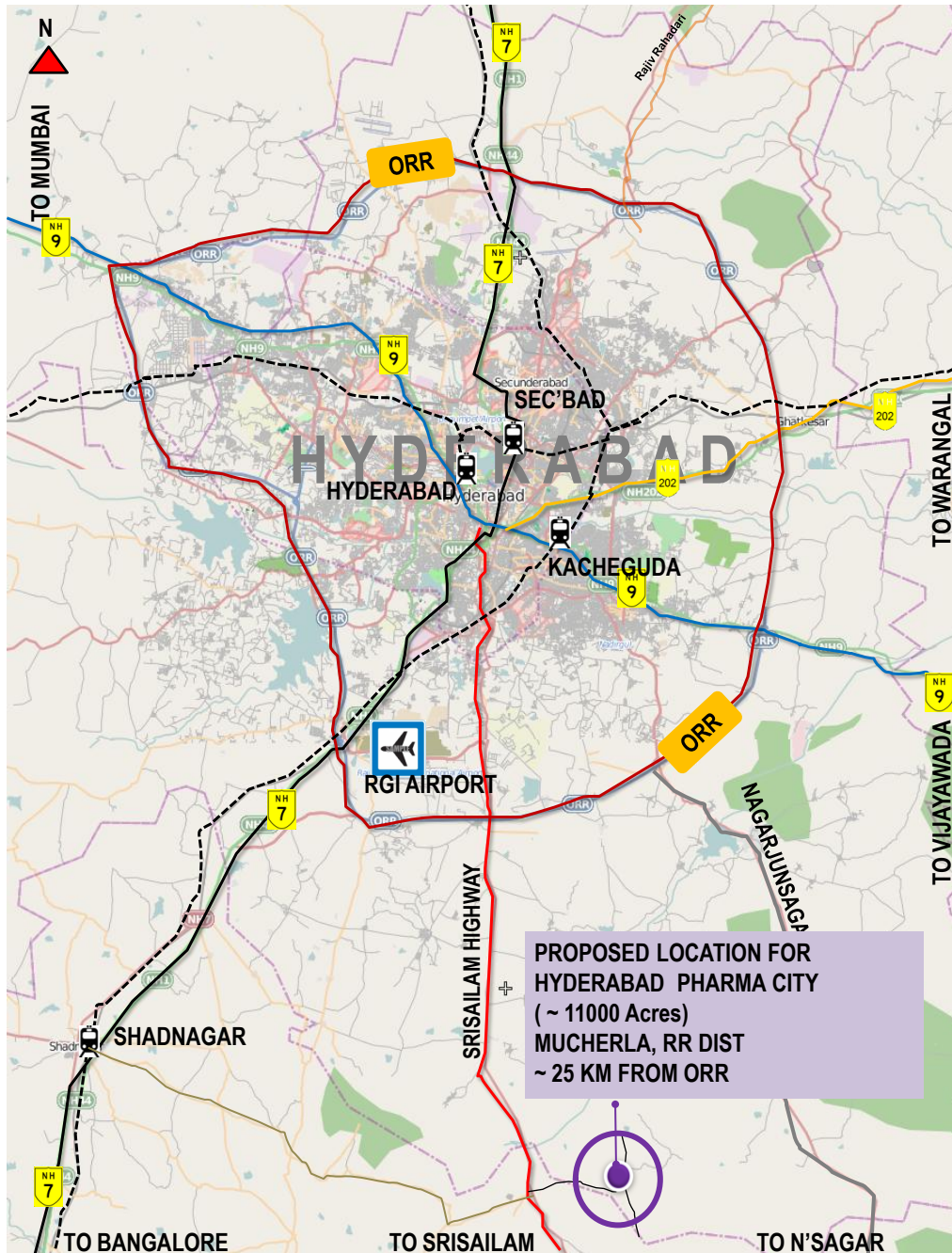
2.1.1 Hyderabad, **capital of the new and vibrant Telangana State** and has been an industrial capital and major economic hub of erstwhile combined State. Pharmaceuticals is one of the major industries in and around Hyderabad apart from Information Technology. Contributing to more than 30% of the bulk drug production in the country, Hyderabad has been named as “**Bulk Drug Capital of India**”. To promote the development of pharmaceutical sector in the state of Telangana, and to strengthen the position of Hyderabad in Pharma Sector, Government of Telangana State (GoTS) intends to promote a greenfield Pharma City in Mucherla and surrounding villages of Ranga Reddy District and Mahbubnagar District in the vicinity of Hyderabad City. Hyderabad Pharma City project is proposed to be developed in over 11,000 Acres of land with world class standards, is one of the flagship projects of GoTS. This Pharma city shall provide plug n play land with necessary infrastructure to the potential investors willing to set up units in the Pharma City. The project envisages development of the following broad components:

- a. Industrial plots, Industrial sheds for pharma units with separate zones for bulk drug units, formulation units etc.
- b. Trunk and internal roads
- c. Solid waste and liquid effluent management facilities (CETP / ZLD facilities)
- d. Water treatment & distribution facilities
- e. Drainage and sewerage facilities
- f. Power substation and distribution
- g. Data and telecom facilities
- h. Support facilities for manufacturing such as Material Testing Lab, Skill Development Centres, Quality Certification Lab /R&D Centre etc
- i. Specialized facilities such as dedicated steam lines, effluent lines etc.
- j. Residential facilities for industrial workers

2.2 PROJECT LOCATION & CONNECTIVITY

2.2.1 Location:

Project site is located around Mucherla Village, Kandukur Mandal – Ranga Reddy District at a distance of approximately 25 km from Hyderabad Outer Ring Road (ORR) and ~ 35 km from Hyderabad International Airport. Location of project site depicted in the map below:



2.2.2 Land details:

The project is proposed in around 11,000 acres. The identified location falls in Kandukur and Yacharam Mandals of Ranga Reddy District and Partly in Amangal Mandal of Mahbubnagar District.

2.2.3 Connectivity:

The proposed site for Pharma City is located near to Hyderabad city and is well connected with rest of the Country by road, rail and air as mentioned below:

- **Road connectivity:** Project site is around 2 Km to the Hyderabad- Srishailam

- Highway and 25 km from Hyderabad Outer Ring Road.
- **Air Connectivity:** Nearest airport to the project site is Hyderabad International Airport located at a distance of ~35 km. The airport operates domestic and international flights to the various parts of the country and rest of the world.
 - **Rail Connectivity:** South Central Railway's broad gauge trunk line passes at a distance of ~46 km. The nearest railway station is Shadnagar Railway Station.

2.3 BROAD SCOPE OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES

The objective of this Consultancy Assignment is to prepare

- ❖ Conceptual Master Plan
- ❖ Detailed Integrated Master Plan
- ❖ Trunk Infrastructure Planning & Design
- ❖ Cost estimates and any other plans essential for the proposed project

The above scope of work is indicative and the same will be further firmed up during the RFP stage of the project.

SECTION III: EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

3.1 PRIMARY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1.1 Interested firms should meet the following prequalification criteria before deciding to submit an EOI response

Technical Experience[^]:

The Applicant should have experience in the following categories:

- Experience of Detailed Master Planning and Infrastructure Planning & Design of Industrial Park/SEZ/Industrial Estate projects of 2500 Acres or above in a single project, undertaken in last seven years preceding the PDD. (At least two projects)

- Experience of Detailed Master Planning and Infrastructure Planning & Design of Pharmaceutical /Chemical Industry Park of 1000 acres or more in a single project for last seven years preceding the PDD. (At least one project)

^The Applicants are requested to provide relevant projects experience details (to the maximum) The Authority reserves right to shortlist the limited number of applicants for next level of selection process. Proof of completion of project including copy of work order/agreement and project completion certificate shall be enclosed.

3.1.2 The evaluation shall be carried out in terms Pass/Fail of the Applicants for both the above mentioned parameters separately. Applicant(s) meeting all the criteria will, subject to the terms of the Bidding Documents, be qualified to submit its(their) Bid(s) for the Project in the next round of Bidding Process (RFP Process)

SECTION IV: EOI - APPLICATION

4.1 SUBMISSION OF EOI

Applicants fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria may submit the proposal to the Vice Chairman & Managing Director, TSIIC in a sealed envelope super scribed with "EOI-Selection of Integrated Master Plan Consultant for Hyderabad Pharma City" containing following information:-

4.2 INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

- 4.2.1. Applicants shall submit the EOI on the prescribed format in English language.
- 4.2.2. The EOI shall be submitted along with a covering letter together with the desired supporting documents and proofs on the letter head of the Applicant with each page of the Document duly signed and stamped by the head or authorized signatory of the Applicant.
- 4.2.3. An Applicant can be disqualified if the Applicant:
- Does not meet the Eligibility Criteria of the Project
 - Does not submit the completed Application as per checklist given in Annexure 1 of this EOI
 - Makes misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in the Application
 - Has record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, litigation history, or financial failures, etc.
 - Application submitted is not accompanied with the requisite documentation or is non-responsive
- 4.2.4. Pre-qualified Bidders will be informed by the Authority through registered post/fax/e-mail.
- 4.2.5. The Authority may contact only the shortlisted firms.
- 4.2.6. The Authority reserves the right to limit the number of shortlisted firms for efficiency.
- 4.2.7. The Two Stage Selection Process shall be carried out for the finalization of the consultant. The selection process involves two stages described briefly as under:

Stage	Description
Stage 1	Global Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI). This is only for the purpose of preparing a short listing of Applicants on the basis of the objective evaluation of credentials of prospective consultants, who fulfill the mandatory eligibility criteria
Stage 2	Request for Proposal' (RFP) shall be given to the Applicants short-listed after the stage 1 and they shall be required to submit separate "Technical Proposals" and "Financial Proposals" as per prescribed procedure. Details with regard to this stage shall be provided in the RFP document to be issued later. System of evaluation of bids shall be QCBS (Quality and Cost Based Selection)

4.2.8. In case of any dispute, Hyderabad, India shall be the jurisdiction for any legal matter and the decision of the Authority shall be final and binding.

4.2.9. The Authority reserves the right to :-

- a. Reject or accept the EOI,
- b. Alter/modify/amend the eligibility criteria in the subsequent stages, if deemed necessary.
- c. Cancel the process and reject all or any of the EOI without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
