


PRESS NOTE

The Government of Telangana has prepared **draft amendments to the Fire Services Act, 1999** with a view to strengthening fire prevention & life safety measures, streamline Fire NOC procedures, strengthen regulation & enforcement mechanisms and ensure greater accountability to enhance public safety in line with current requirements, emerging risks, and advancements in fire safety technologies.

As part of a transparent and participatory approach, the draft amendments are hereby placed in the **public domain** for seeking views / suggestions from stakeholders and the general public.
